Contribution of trailblazing forest industries' women will be highlighted at National Forest Industry Awards in September

Women in Australia's forest industries will be a celebrated at the Australian Forest Products Association's (AFPA) Gala Dinner and National Forest Industries Awards, at Parliament House in Canberra this September, Chief Executive Officer of AFPA, Ross Hampton said today.

- Innovation in Business
- Innovation in Training.

Mr Hampton said the awards are an excellent opportunity for recognition across the supply chain of Australia's forest industries.

"I strongly encourage our forest industries businesses and organisations to think hard about their people who go above and beyond in furthering the cause across the different categories - then put them forward for these awards.

"The Gala Dinner at Parliament House's Great Hall will be an important occasion for forest industries nationally, and these major awards are big part of it," Mr Hampton concluded.
