




Key Driver of Economic Growth



Half of Tasmania is Forested



- **5,727 jobs** generated
- \$1.2B industry value

- 3.4M hectares of Tasmania is forested
 - 91% Native Forests
 - 9% Plantations
- Of the Native Forest, 69% cent is either wet or dry eucalypt forest



Production Snapshot



- 5.8M tonnes of wood fibre produced annually
- 78% of volume comes from plantations
- Plantations (302,000 hectares) are made up of 25% softwoods and 75% hardwoods
